FOR EXAMPLE:

You are looking for M&S models that are Y2K compliant.

Here is how you proceed:

- ◆ Go to NAVMSMO web site.
- ◆ Click on [SEARCH](#) menu item on the left side (below LOG ON).
- ◆ Click on [Advanced M&S Resources Search](#)
- ◆ Use [Create a new query](#)
- ◆ Pick under [Resources Models and Simulation](#) and then click [Next](#).
- ◆ In the first [Where](#) field choose [Y2K Compliant](#). You may have to scroll down.
- ◆ In the sub-window pick [YES](#) and then click [Submit](#).
- ◆ The sub-window disappears and you are back to
- ◆ Step: [The Query - Selecting Your Fields](#) window.
- ◆ Now Click [VIEW REPORT](#)
